Measles and the MMR vaccine

Measles cases are currently on the rise in the UK. There is evidence that there are many children and young people who are at risk of becoming extremely ill from this serious disease. The best way to protect your child from measles is to ensure that they have had two doses of the MMR vaccine.

The MMR vaccine provides protection against measles, mumps and rubella, in one combined vaccine. It is normally offered to children when they are one year old, and when they are three years and four months old. However, there are many children and young people in the UK who are missing one or both doses of the MMR vaccine.
