



Consultation launched on new Summer Programme

Dear Parents/Carers

We are excited to share we are exploring the launch of a pioneering summer programme hosted at Townley, which would be open to students currently in Years 7 to 10 with Years 11 to 13 taking part as Peer-Mentors.

The <u>Townley Bright Futures Summer Programme</u> aims to equip young people to be leaders in their lives and society, creating a brighter future for all.

Designed by award-winning youth training organisation Future Foundations with Townley's active support, there would be a mix of onsite workshops and activities themed by stream, off-site trips, and guest speakers.

We are considering running 2-3 weeks with 3-4 course streams as follows:

- **Future of Food** Students will explore the significance of food in our lives, covering its impact on people and planet. Students will visit food markets, learn about nutrition science, engage in cooking diverse cuisines, and develop their own ideas for sustainable future food.
- **Social Leadership** Focused on the Sustainable Development Goals, this stream empowers students to lead themselves and others. Through learning about leadership and social action, students will be inspired to design and implement their own social action project.
- **Voices for Change** Designed to equip students to express their passions and advocate for social issues through spoken word and theatre.
- Al for Social Good Students will delve into the world of artificial intelligence and its potential to solve global challenges.
